**Applied Behavior Analysis Policy Update (RPC.0144.7100)**

Dear Provider,

AmeriHealth Caritas Delaware has updated its **Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) Services Reimbursement Policy (RPC.0144.7100)** effective July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026

**Key Updates Include:**

**Effective July 24<sup>th</sup>, 2026**, claims for ABA services must accurately reflect the qualifications of the rendering provider through the use of applicable modifiers, when required, in accordance with policy RPC.0144.7100.

**The Policy Clarifies:**

- Appropriate use of modifiers HN, HO and HP based on provider credentials.
- Circumstances in which ABA services may be reported without a modifier when rendered by a qualified technician under applicable supervision requirements.
- Reimbursement methodologies associated with provider level modifiers.
- Documentation and billing requirements for ABA services.

**Provider Action:**

Providers should review current billing practices and ensure ABA claims are submitted in accordance with the updated policy requirements.

**Claims submitted with missing, incorrect or inconsistent modifiers may be denied or reimbursed at a reduced rate.**
